

**Log Book.** There is a 'Log Book' in the Church on the table near the side door. If you enter the Church building for any reason please fill in your details as in name and date of visit before you leave as we have been told we need to keep such records by the Diocese.

**Sunday Service Booking System.** If you wish to book your seat to attend Church in the actual building on Sundays then please contact the Church Office via email or telephone by Wednesday at 1pm of the week you wish to attend. **Please note we are now using the original landline for all queries, 01245-284663!**

**Sunday Service Etiquette.** Only turn up to Sunday services in the building itself if you have booked a seat in advance. Chairs will be labelled with family/individual names as needed and are likely to change each week so do not assume you will be sitting in the same place each visit. Please sit on the labelled seat(s) and not those next to it/them. Entry will be through the side entrance to the church and exit through the main door of the Church (unless disabled access is required) and will be strictly controlled for the sake of social distancing. Be aware that you must hand sanitise on entry and exit of the building (hand sanitiser will be provided). You will find an 'Order of Service' on your seat which should be taken home with you following the service. Please bring a Bible with you if you wish as we cannot make those in Church available for use at the moment. However, the Bible passage will be printed with the 'Order of Service'. Toilet facilities will be open if needed but everyone should use the disabled loo with handles, etc cleaned immediately following that use. **Face coverings are now MANDATORY for all those attending the service in the building.**

**Crosslinks Mission Sunday.** If you were unable to make your donation to our mission partner last week at our 'Mission Sunday Service' and wish to do so then please do this on-line using the BACS information on the front of the newsletter (putting a note to say what the donation is for so we can ensure it goes to the correct place). If you are unable to donate via BACS then Eleanor has once again offered to collect monetary donations. Hence, please let her know if she needs to pay you a visit!
