
### **Service Etiquette**

**NHS Test & Trace App.** We advise all those who can to download this to their smartphone and use it **every time** they enter either the Church or the Church Centre. Please note that for those who don't have a smartphone, alternative contact tracing methods such as pen-and-paper logbooks will be in place in both venues.

**APCM Plus PCC & Deanery Synod Vacancies.** This year's APCM will be held on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October at 8pm in the church and over zoom (either visually or by telephone). Physical attendance will be by ticket only, with priority given to those unable to join in remotely. Please let Amanda know by Monday 21<sup>st</sup> October if you would like to attend in the Church building. PCC and Deanery synod elections will take place a week after the meeting with the closing date 2 weeks later. Only those who attend the APCM in some form will be entitled to vote. Forms should be returned to Amanda, preferably electronically. The annual report will imminently be emailed out and hard copies will only be made available to those not on email.

**Harvest & Foodbank.** This year's Harvest Sunday will be on 11<sup>th</sup> October (Today!). Due to obvious reasons (their stock is currently very very high in addition to the COVID situation!) we will not be having our formal collection for the Food Bank. However, at their request, we will have an opportunity to have a second "harvest" thanksgiving in the New Year when we are able. For those who still wish to donate food our Church collection box has been re-instated for this purpose (under the sanitising station on entry). Inside this box there is a collection tin for financial donations which we would strongly suggest is the best way to offer help at the present time rather than food donations.
