### **Church Building Now Open For Sunday Services**

Services are now inside the building on Sunday mornings (as well as being live-streamed!). Risk assessments have been completed and we are as confident as we can be that we are open COVID safely. However, we continue to acknowledge that this is currently something not afforded to many others. So, we continue to act responsibly and this means the following :-

1. Seats must be booked by lunchtime on Wednesday. If a seat isn't booked, then it will not be available the following Sunday. This will be on a first come first served basis.
2. Bookings should be by email if at all possible.
3. Please arrive and leave promptly at the end of the service, emptying from the back.
4. Doors will be left fully open for ventilation purposes, so it might get a little chilly!
5. A reminder that face coverings are to be worn at all times, and hand sanitizers used on entering and exiting the building.

As the 'group of six/two households' rule is now in force. Please feel free to gather outside in these groups after the service if you wish. However, please do not move from group to group if at all possible!

**Church Office.** As lockdown eases a little the church office will remain virtual (and continue to be so as the rules relax until further notice).
