

**Car Park Closed.** Please be advised that the church car park (including the gravel parking to the right of the church building and also the concreted area leading to the old church centre door) will be closed this week from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July inclusive. Work is being done on the car park as well as the area behind the Church Centre. The limited parking that remains available will be in constant use by workmen and/or Church Centre hirers so be aware that other parking will need to be sought for this week!

**Thank You.** To all who made monetary offerings following our mission partner Ruth Webster's visit where she talked to us about her work with United Mission to Nepal. A total of £607 was raised to support her ongoing work.

**Seat Booking.** Please be advised that today was the final Sunday when seats needed to be booked as a result of the government roadmap removing restrictions. Be advised that seats are now one metre distanced in bubble blocks and, those attending, can choose where they sit (although we would be grateful if people could sit in the smaller blocks if they are attending on their own or as a couple). Sitting in bubbles is a must until after the 19<sup>th</sup>. Similarly, hand sanitising will remain in place as will mask wearing until at least this date. Always ensure that you hand sanitise before picking up your 'Order of service' and finding a seat.

**Summer Services.** In the expectation that there will be fewer restrictions after 19<sup>th</sup> July, we welcome everyone to come back to church, in the church building, as soon as you feel able to do so. From Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July (next Sunday!) there will be a series of all age services for the whole family at 10.30am each week. Please be encouraged to come along and worship Jesus with your church family. Also, please be advised that our services will not be live streamed from the 19<sup>th</sup> July and consequently we will no longer be sending out CDs for those without internet access as they should no longer be needed.
